Item No. 14 Address by the Outgoing President, Dr. Sarita Bhalerao.

Good evening respected Seniors, ladies, and gentlemen. As I complete my tenure as President of MOGS I would like to share with you a few glimpses of the year gone by.

My team was installed on May 16, 2022, during the second wave of the Covid pandemic. As there was a lockdown our installation was virtual. Dr. Bhumika Kotecha Mundhe and Dr. Shrutika made a unique handover video in which all the office bearers danced to waltz music. Dr. Rishma Pai handed over the medal to me with a floral bouquet.

Our first conference was `Obstetric Emergencies`. Item No.18 Address by the President, Dr. Niranjana Chavan.

Presidential Address by Dr. Niranjana Chavan 69th President of MOGS at the 88th AGM of MOGS:

Thank you so much, Dr. Sarita, Dr. Suvarna, our trustee Dr. Shyam Desai, Dr. Shailesh Kore, the past treasurer, my team Dr. Rajendra Sankpal, Dr. Geeta and all office bearers and members of the managing committee, seniors, colleagues, and friends. Today, I stand in front of you as the 69th president of my esteemed organization the Mumbai Obstetrics and Gynaecological Society founded in 1934 and it's a pleasure to be installed as the President on the 88 AGM at 7 p.m and 1 minute on 16 of April 2022 which adds to eight number, which is a coincidence that has occurred and my journey begins now with all of you. I start by giving tribute to Lord Avatar Meher Baba who said "The real happiness lies in making others happy" and that's what I've been trying to do. I am a third-generation doctor in the family.

"Hard work puts you, where good luck can find you."

I start with a tribute to my grandfather Ramchandra Kanhoji Gadekar, he was a BA, Bachelor of Teaching from the University of Mumbai. He is the first Indian to get a Diploma in Education from the University of Scotland Edinburgh and he was there for one and a half years. This was in 1937-1938 and then he returned. He became the education officer in the Bombay Presidency and following independence in 1947, he became the Director of Education till he was there alive. So that was my roots, deeply embedded in education. It was equivalent to a Ph.D. in those days. And this is my mother a gynecologist, MBBS from BJ medical college, she was a woman with grit and determination. She pursued her DGO from KEM and Wadia after 9 years of marriage. I have seen my father always encouraging her. She was an Rh-Negative mother and I was O-positive. I was in-utero when she was studying DGO. She had spotting and bleeding PV on and off and she was in double mind about whether to continue the pregnancy or not a gynecologist advised her to undergo MTP and she was scheduled for it. On the day of the surgery, on the OT table, something happened and she changed her mind, got off the table, and refused to undergo MTP and here I am standing in front of you. Otherwise, I would have been somewhere as an abortus in the basket of the operation theatre, that's destiny. My father was an advocate, notary public, BA, LLB, Municipal Councilor, Chairman of various Government Undertakings, and on various boards of committees like the Censor Board member, Police Public Liason committee, etc. For 40 years he was in the field of encouraging and empowering members from the middle class, and lower middle class. He was a very strong pillar to my mother and always supported her endeavors of starting a dispensary and MTP center and Nursing Home in the suburb called Andheri. I realized the meaning of the word 'woman empowerment' from him. My father-in-law passed away recently. He was a thorough gentleman and I do miss him, as he would be present today at this august gathering and he is there looking from up, all of them from the sky and I might be happy standing here, to see them that they are wishing me. My mother-in-law is still there she is watching me live on Zoom. Thanks to the love and affection all of them have given to me and of course, my wife Dr. Komal who has been a strong, rock-solid support beside me. This is what we were we are sitting at the highest point in the world that was in Nepal it is one place where they say that is the highest point that you can go we all know Mount Everest is there, and this is my wedding pic and see how I look now.

I hope you can recognize me in the photo, where I am, that's the crying guy on the shoulder of my father, and that's the 10th standard photo of Hansraj Morarji Public School, where I did my schooling in Andheri Mumbai suburb thereafter, I landed up at Seth G. S. Medical College doing medicine, MBBS. Can you recognize me in this photo? I doubt you can. I have changed a lot. See, that is me, extreme right second row from the top. I was always a shy, introverted guy. Seth G.S. Medical College taught me a lot of things in my life and just across the road Wadia Maternity Hospital, the biggest iconic place ever I visited in my second year and then in my third year of MBBS and thereafter in internship. In G.S. Medical College, I was very lucky to see Dr. N. D. Motashaw teach me, I have heard Dr. V. N. Purandare sir giving lectures. Dr. Usha Krishna madam used to be there all

the time and Dr. Shirish Sheth sir was always being very immaculate and nice, talking, and explaining the different intricacies of surgeries all the time. In Wadia Hospital I had Dr. Ajit Mehta, Dr. M. N. Parikh, Dr. C. B. Purandare, Dr. Adi Dastur, and Dr. Nayana Dastur always welcoming, always well dressed and I was in awe when I saw them. Dr. Mehroo Hansotia, Dr. Manju Matalia, Dr. S N Daftary, Dr. Shyam Desai, and Dr. Nanavati were all my teachers and of course, how can I forget Dr. Nozer Sheriar, Dr. Amar Bhide, who taught me the forceps, the vacuum and many, many of them. Of course, my registrars, my lecturers, Dr. Rishma Pai, Dr. Swati Allahabadia, Dr. Jatin Shah, and Dr. Moni Shah used to take secret clinics for us as undergraduate and postgraduate students. It was a great journey which was a wonderful experience, I had in Wadia Maternity Hospital and Seth GS Medical College.

I landed up in Sion Hospital in 1992 to do my post-graduation and there I had my madam, Dr. P R Vaidya who used to ask me "Tu jevlas ka?" and she used to be very nice and kind to me, always motherly. I recollect in operation theatre we used to have 12-14 cases lined up and at that time Sion hospital was in a different situation and the 15 kgs. weight, which I gained during my internship, I lost during the residency program courtesy of Dr. Gautam Allahabadia, Dr. Santosh Nikumbh, my lecturer and registrar. They made me run from pillar to post and I was totally in disarray by the whole situation. Everything was different as compared to the symphony orchestra you find in Wadia Hospital. There I met Dr. P. K. Shah Sir and of course, Dr. C. N. Purandare Sir, following my post-graduation. Passion and zeal for academics, research, and education were my forte. It was embedded in my soul by these mentors. I'm indebted to them for whatever today I am, standing here in front of you. These are some photos, which I have with me to share with you. You can see Dr. C. N. Purandare, Dr. Adi Dastur, myself, and Komal looking there, this photo was taken at AICOG Ahmedabad in 1999, and then the journey started where I interacted with CN Sir, Arul Sir, and the rest of the FIGO members in 2000 when I landed up in Washington DC. It was a wonderful experience. 22 years have passed, and since then things have changed, and those memories I cherish. Both of them have come to various conferences and we had workshops being arranged on ultrasound where Dr. P K Shah used to be there at the IFUMB conference, and the IAGE conference with Dr. Khandwala sir and I could see Dr. Hrishikesh Pai there demonstrating hysteroscopic cannulation and I still remember so many members had come from abroad and we were shown hysteroscopic surgeries. Seeing the working of Dr. P K Shah, and Dr. Purandare in various stages of MOGS, FOGSI, FIGO, and other organizations made me understand to realize my potential to serve our women population. I am still learning and trying to inculcate good things taught to me by both of them.

"There are friends, there is family, and then there are friends that become family."

You know this guy (Dr. Hrishikesh Pai) in the center is always jovial, always kind-hearted always talking. The first thing, he will come towards you, he will put a hand on the shoulder or he will shake hand and I had a wonderful journey with him. Hrishi, it's not only between you and me, but our friendship is because of our parents knowing each other for a long period when my mom was in Seth G. S. Medical College and your dad was there as HOD PSM. Hrishi you are being very supportive, very kind, and always encouraging. These are the pictures of AICOG in 2013 which we organized along with Dr. Nozer Sheriar sir, as scientific chair, and it was a wonderful experience that we went through.

Nandita is an iconic personality! Always a diva I can say, so nice always with your sparkling eyes, I can say, hazelnut magnetic eyes. We had a wonderful time altogether for so many decades and again our journey is not between you and me but it starts with our parents. Both our fathers knew each other and that's how this is going to continue in the next generation and the next generation and henceforth. Thank you so much for being there always with me.

Rishma, what can I say about you, you are a wonderful enigmatic personality. I cherish those moments when we as MOGS members in 2000, 2003, 2006, and 2009, used to travel together campaigning, seeking votes, going from Sion hospital then to Wadia, KEM then to JJ hospital, Cama hospital, calling people sitting in the car. It was a wonderful journey through which we went. I think all of us have gone through this process and it is so nice of you that we have come together, all this way.

Shanta, my dearest elder sister. Always she will be very frank with me and she will tell me that, this is right and this is wrong and I just have to listen to her, the matter ends! I just have to keep myself mum. She is always so caring about me and she will call me anytime, at 11'oclock 12'oclock even before you became FOGSI President I remember today you had a journey from Pune to Mumbai and you might have recollected that journey which we went through together, 12 years back when we argued with the driver, he said something to you and I really was very angry about it, but anyway, things have changed. We both have mellowed down over the ages.

Dr. Bipin Pandit is there always there, a guiding force in suburbs, this is why we were dancing and we had a wonderful time. We have been sharing, traveling together, and meeting people around and so wonderful that we had an opportunity to meet doctor N D Motashaw madam. Today she is 96 years old and I wish her all the best health of times, the founding member of MOGS.

Doctors Day 1st July 2022 where we will be meeting and having wonderful fellowship. September 2022 will be Ovarian Cancer Awareness Month. 3rd and 4th of September 2022, we are having MOGS SHARP Conference (Safety and Health Attributes with Research and Prevention) which will be at the St. Regis Hotel, Mumbai and we will be having 3 Pre-Congress workshops where we will be tying up with IAGE, ISAR, and other organizations.

We have FOGSI managing committee meeting in September 2022, and I welcome all of you the managing council members to the same. MOGS will be bidding for AICOG 2025. You all will be with me, and it will be an amazing journey, where we will be celebrating the 75th year which is the diamond jubilee year of FOGSI and we will have a wonderful time together. I am blessed to have the AAGL international conference on October 6th - 9th 2022, to be held at Westin Convention Centre, Mumbai along with IAGE Dr. Bhaskar Pal and Dr. Prakash Trivedi supported by MOGS and supported by Dr. Shanthakumari FOGSI.

In November, my friends, Sarita Bhalerao, Ameet Patki, and Bhaskar Pal will be doing AICC RCOG and we welcome all of you to come for that wonderful conference. In January, we have cervical cancer awareness month. CYCLOTHON FOR HER will be also done in January 2023.




