PRESIDENTS MESSAGE

From the Desk of

Dr. Rishma Dhillon Pai

President MOGS 2020 – 2021



Dear Colleagues,

Let me begin by thanking you for the trust and confidence that you placed in me by electing me as President of this prestigious organization, The Mumbai Obstetrics and Gynaecological Society. It's been a long journey of 43 years as MOGS member and 20 years on the managing committee, before I could reach this position. In fact, I am one of the only two Presidents in the 87 year old history of MOGS, who became FOGSI President before becoming MOGS president. I had the privilege of serving as President of Indian Society of Assisted Reproduction (ISAR) and Indian Association of Gynaecological Endoscopists (IAGE) before attaining this esteemed position.

I took over as MOGS president on 10th May 2020, amidst the first wave of the Covid 19 pandemic. I had prepared meticulously since a year for my tenure but had to suddenly and completely change course and venture into uncharted territory, that of the virtual digital world, new and yet unexplored.

We changed design, direction and execution but not the core spirit, plan and sentiment ! Our installation was truly unique and probably the first in FOGSI on a virtual platform. We followed it up with 62 large and medium sized conferences and CMEs, attended by more than 65,000 doctors, a record for MOGS. In fact, just our FEM Conference, had delegates from more than 127 countries participating and free posters from Europe being sent, a first again. Our annual conference attendance of 4,200 has also been unheard of. So you lose some but win some too!

We did lots of new things this year, including making a new and meaningful flag for MOGS, giving all our members a beautiful keepsake certificate, creating archives with video recordings of all past presidents, introducing 'MOGS Masti' with attractive prizes and 'Fit is It' our mantra, in every event that we did.

The 'MOGS Personality of the year' contest received a very enthusiastic response as did the 'Video of the year' award. The 20 academic short videos 'Pearls of Wisdom' were appreciated by all, as were the newsletters, MOGS Musings, MOGS Matters and MOGS media which were sent out regularly.

For the first time a 'Youngistan Conference- by the Young for the Young at heart', was held and was a huge success. Our office also received a makeover and all the presidents photos were put up on the walls, as a beautiful memory for all that they contributed. What I am most proud of this year is our 'V Care and Share' Programme. Throughout the year on many occasions we sent out hundreds of care packages with Covid essentials, such as masks, sanitizers, protein supplements, nutritional foods and snacks to pregnant and post-natal patients and resident doctors in all BMC and peripheral hospitals in Mumbai.

We included lecturers and heads of units with small thank you gifts on several occasions as our way of saying thank you for fighting against all odds and saving lives while risking their own. We provided necessary items they needed, PPE kits, N95 masks, pulse oximeters, digital thermometers, NST machine, BP instruments etc. at the beginning of the pandemic, when all this was in short supply. On special occasions like Holi, Christmas we sent out small gifts which helped cheer them up.

We conducted free health camps also. As our last activity we gave pendrives with many hours of practical teaching to all resident doctors in Mumbai, as teaching has really suffered this year due to the pandemic.

My year as President of MOGS has come to an end. It's been very satisfying, challenging and an amazing learning experience. It's been a year which has created history by being the first fully digital year of MOGS and the learnings from this year will really change the way MOGS functions in the future. I would like to thank from the bottom of my heart Dr. Anahita Chauhan, my Secretary and Dr. Rajendra Sankpal my treasurer this year who were a huge support to me, as well as the entire managing committee and the Youth Council. The staff of MOGS worked really hard despite the extremely difficult situation of the pandemic. The team at Onference with Makrand Desai at the helm, were our lifeline this year.

A big thank you to all our academic partners without whose help we would not have been able to do all the activities that we did. Last but not the least, a big thank you to my family, Hrishikesh, Arnab, Anvisha, Ravi, and my sister Poonam Dhillon, Anmol and Paloma for all their love, help and support through this year and always. Endings are always difficult, but I believe when something ends, there are new beginnings, new hopes and opportunities and new things to be excited for. Thanks a lot to all of you for always being with me through the years and for your support and encouragement. I will always cherish these memories.

Wall of fame

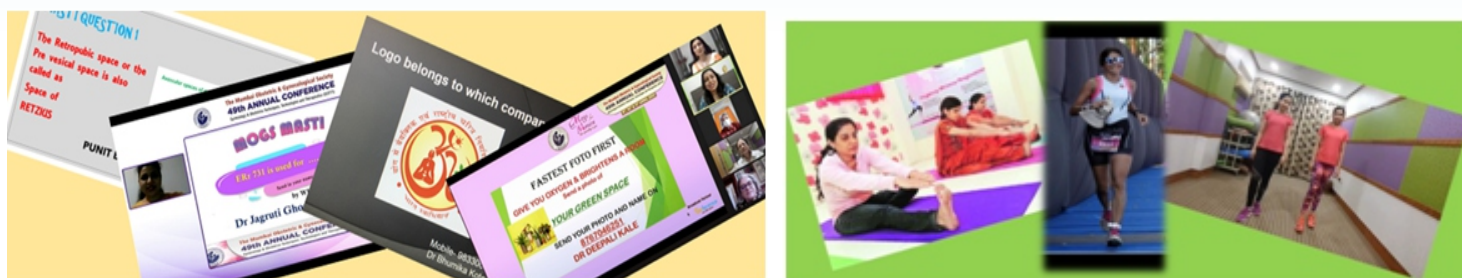
The MOGS office didn't have the photos of the Past Presidents on its wall. They were put up during this year. And we proudly call it – the Wall of Fame.

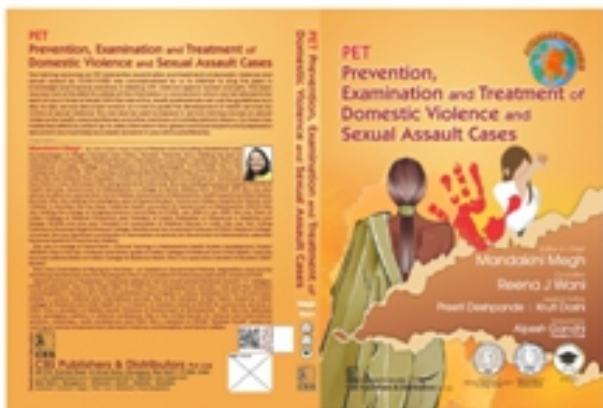
MOGS MATTERS:

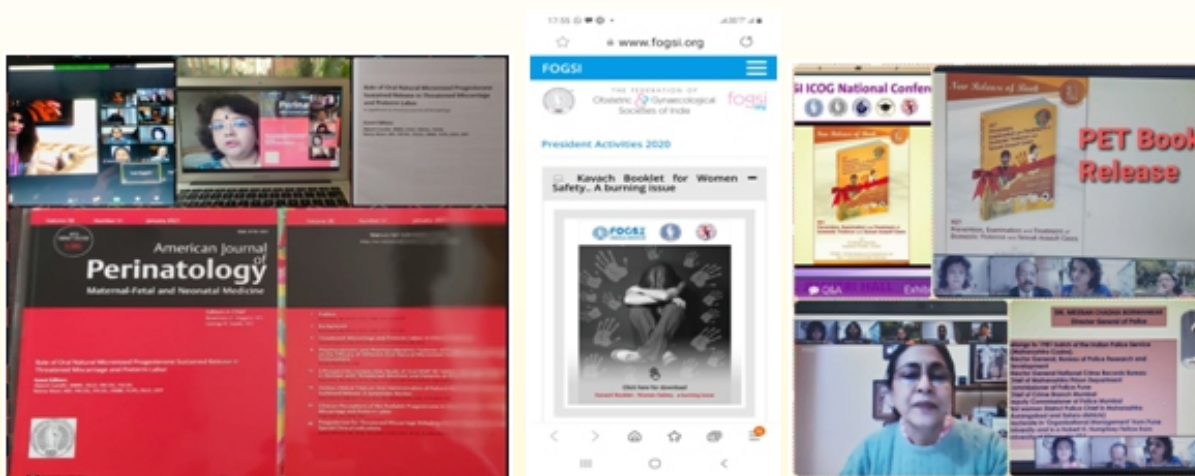

MOGS Conference on “Focus on First Trimester” on 21st June, 2020.

The Focus on First Trimester or the FIT conference was held on an online platform on 21st June 2020. The conference was conducted in association with 4 FOGSI committees -Midlife Management Committee, Foods & Drugs and Medico Surgical Equipment Committee, Genetic & Fetal Medicine Committee and Imaging Science Committee.

We had two role plays with doctors as performers addressing common queries and common ailments in pregnancy. This was the first time that such a session was successfully conducted in an online conference. This were followed by talks on Teratogenicity and Periconceptional counselling by Dr Reena Wani and Dr Sujata Dalvi respectively. 'Prediction and Diagnosis of Hemoglobinopathies: are we doing enough?' by Dr Natarajan, and Dr Archana Baser on 'First Trimester screening of Eclampsia'. Our esteemed international faculty Dr Manjiri Khare, completely bowled the audience by presenting her series of interesting cases of genetic and teratogenic anomalies detected in first trimester.

Chief Guest Ms Sonali Kulkarni, a well-known acclaimed actress with down to earth and pleasing personality touched our audience. She spoke from her heart about her experience with doctors, and showed immense respect for doctors, stating that they are the real heroes. The prestigious MOGS Dr Dossibai J R Dadabhoy Silver Jubilee Oration for the first time in virtual format was given by Dr Asma Khalil From UK, who went in depth about first trimester ultrasound in twin pregnancy.

The office bearer in charge was Dr. Shailesh Kore, and conveners for the program were Dr Purnima Satoskar, Rajendra Nagarkatti, Dr Ganpat Sawant, Dr Komal Chavan, Dr Mansi Medhekar and Dr Rohan Palshetkar. MOCs for the conference were Dr Unnati Mamtora, Dr Shrutika Thakkar and Dr Aditi Tandon. Total registrations were 1000.

MOGS Virtual Conference on Conflict to Clarity focus on Controversial Gynecological issues on Sunday, August 30, 2020

This mega-event was held on an online platform on Sunday August 30th, 2020 from 4pm-8:30pm. The conference was conducted in association with three committees of FOGSI- Endoscopic Committee, Sexual Medicine Committee and Urogynaecology Committee.

For the first time in the history of MOGS, Free paper presentations were conducted on a digital platform. Papers were invited in 3 categories- conflict to clarity in obstetrics, conflict to clarity in gynaecology and interesting cases. A total of 48 papers were received. 12 Senior gynaecologists were invited as judges for the sessions..

The Chief Guest was Shri Anup Jalota, a well-known Indian singer, musician and actor, best known for his performances in hindu devotional music. Shri Anup Jalota addressed the delegates and sang two beautiful devotional songs.

The inauguration ceremony began with Dr. Rishma Pai (President MOGS), addressing the delegates. She announced that MOGS has received the prestigious 'Covid Essential Heroes Award' during the CSR health impact awards function for the 'V Care and Share' programme.

Dr. Ramani Devi, Dr. Rajendra Sankpal, Dr. Kuldeep Jain gave talks and we had an excellent pre-recorded lecture on non- surgical ablative therapy of adenomyosis by international stalwarts, Dr. Rudy Leon and Dr. Hugo C from Germany.

An interactive panel discussion on Her Unspoken Problems moderated by Dr. Suvarna Khadilkar and Dr. Sanket Pisat was very informative.

The last session focused on fibroids. Dr. Andrew Brill (USA) spoke on Laparoscopic Myomectomy (concept necessity and complications) and Dr. Charles Koh (USA) spoke on suturing in Myomectomy (single or multiple layer).

The office bearer in charge was Dr. Rajendra Sankpal. The convenors for the programme were Dr. Reena Wani and Dr. Nargendra Sardeshpande and co-convenors were Dr. Sanket Pisat, Dr. Priya Vora and Dr. Gaurav Desai. The total number of delegates were 1318.

Total entries received for Slogan and E poster(creative) competition were 13 and 17 respectively.

MOGS V Care and Share Program by Dr. Rishma Pai

This was an initiative started at the beginning of the year in COVID Pandemic situation. Dr. Hrishikesh Pai is the Convener of this program.

Objectives and priority of the program discussed at the first MCM were as follows:

- Support and help all our members who are at the frontline, and working towards saving thousands of lives, specially of pregnant mothers
- They need encouragement, support
- Logistic support- Our focus will be more on providing PPE Kits, monitors, drugs to our doctors- as per their requirement
- Teams formed all over Mumbai to reach out to help
- Ex officio –Dr Rishma Pai, Dr Anahita Chauhan, Dr Rajendra Sankpal
- Conveners -Dr Hrishikesh Pai, Dr Nozer Sheriar

Dr. Hrishikesh Pai spoke of request from major municipal hospitals for assistance required in COVID times. They are in urgently need of PPE-Sterile, N95 Masks, Fetal Doppler, cordless mike, small pulse oximeters, NST machines etc. This fund can take care of all the difficulties. Initially Dr. Hrishikesh Pai, along with Dr. Rishma Pai, asked all Heads of Departments of ObGyn in major public hospitals for their urgent requirements during the pandemic. After written replies were obtained, Dr. Nozer Sheriar, Dr. Jaydeep Tank and Dr. Atul Ganatra (who had informed us that he would be able to procure a good rate for purchase of equipment from vendors), were consulted.

Glimpses of MOGS V Care & Share Program Activities in the Year 2020-21

The MOGS V Care and Share Program is continuing its efforts in helping frontline workers and patients during the Covid pandemic down the past year.

Activities June 2020

This program was launched by the President Dr. Rishma Pai during her installation on 10th May 2020, and details were discussed in the first MCM on 20th May 2020

MOGS purchased through its own funds: 1 NST machine, 500 PPE, 600 N 95 masks, 15 pulse oximeters, 6 BP apparatus, 16 fetal dopplers and 3 infrared thermometers. The total cost incurred by us was Rs.5,73,045/-.

At the outset, the program was kickstarted by a generous personal donation from Dr. Hrishikesh Pai and Dr. Rishma Pai. Our past member Dr. Shobhana Mohandas and Dr. Nandini Ram Babu also made contributions. We would like to place on record our thanks and appreciation to all the donors.

The first round of equipment was personally distributed on 2nd June 2020 by MOGS Secretary Dr. Anahita Chauhan, along with managing committee members Dr. Mansi Medhekar and Dr. Unnati Mamtara, and Youth Council member Dr. Medha Tankiwala, to the 6 major hospitals.

We had appealed to all our industry partners to help us in this program. Sun Pharma came forward with a substantial donation of PPE, N 95 masks, face shields, infrared thermometers and gloves which made it possible for us to honour requests from peripheral BMC hospitals as well.

The second lot of equipment, including an NST machine to Nair Hospital, was personally distributed on 10th and 11th June 2020 by MOGS Secretary Dr. Anahita Chauhan, along with managing committee member Dr. Gaurav Desai, and Youth Council members Dr. Mohit Saraogi, Dr. Siddesh Iyer and Dr. Medha Tankiwala, to the 6 major hospitals as well as the 5 peripheral hospitals.

In August 2020, we focused on:

- Income generation through private donations
 - o We were able to raise an additional Rs. 1,03,000/- from private donors, through sms campaigns and personal appeals
- Distribution of care packages to breast feeding Covid positive and negative mothers
 - o 200 packages were distributed to select BMC teaching hospitals as part of the World Breastfeeding Week celebrations.
 - o These packages contained masks, hand sanitizers, soap and protein powder sachets, along with a note in Marathi encouraging mothers to breast feed
 - o This was done through our own funds (approximately Rs. 21,000/-) along with donation of protein powder sachets by Abbott
 - o Dr. Reena Wani and Dr. Madhuri Mehendale along with Youth Council members Dr. Pradnya Supe and Dr. Pradnya Chengade helped in this activity
- Distribution of care packages to our resident doctors
 - o Our major activity in August was to focus on the health, immunity and nutrition of resident doctors who are working tirelessly during the pandemic
 - o We distributed 330 care packages to residents in all the major public and teaching hospitals - KEM, Sion, Nair, JJ, Cooper, Wadia, Bombay Hospital, Somaiya and DY Patil
 - o Each package had healthy non - perishable snacks like chikki, oats cookies, peanuts and non- fried snacks which we purchased through our own funds (approximately Rs. 25,000/-)
 - o Youth Council members Dr. Bhumika Kotecha Mundhe and Dr. Nidhi Shah helped with this activity
 - o This activity was supported by Zuventus who added surgical face masks, caps, sanitizer, and a month's supply of zinc tablets to each package

Support to Family Planning Association of India (FPAI)

- o FPAI has been doing excellent work through the pandemic and have continued to offer all FP services through their centres in Mumbai to more than 5600 clients
- o They appealed to us for help with protective equipment
- o We donated 50 PPE, 50 N 95, 20 face shields and 200 surgical masks to them which were greatly appreciated

September 2020

The MOGS V Care and Share Program is continuing its efforts in helping frontline workers and patients during the Covid pandemic. In this month, we focused on:

- o Income generation through private donations: additional Rs. 65,000/- from private donors, through sms campaigns and personal appeals
- Distribution of care packages to patients
 - o 200 packages distributed to patients in select teaching hospitals
 - o These packages contain masks, soap, and chikki which have been purchased through our own funds, along with a note in Marathi encouraging patients to stay safe
 - o Torrent Pharma added N 95, hand sanitizer, calcium and Vitamin D tablets and provided logistical support in the distribution
- Distribution of care packages to resident doctors and Lecturers
 - o Our major activity in July and August was to focus on the health, immunity and nutrition of doctors
 - o This was greatly appreciated by the residents and the HODs and as per their suggestion, this month we have included the lecturers as well
 - o We distributed 400 care packages to residents and lecturers in all the major public and teaching hospitals - KEM, Sion, Nair, JJ, Cooper, Wadia, Bombay Hospital, Somaiya and DY Patil
 - o This activity is supported by Torrent who have added N 95 masks, sanitizer, nuts and calcium and Vitamin D tablets to each package. They are also helping with the distribution
- Distribution of token of appreciation to senior faculty
 Approximately 100 senior professors and associate professors received a small token of appreciation, along with a letter, from MOGS

December 2020

The MOGS V Care and Share Program is continuing its efforts in helping frontline workers and patients during the Covid pandemic. We received excellent feedback from Heads of Department of various teaching hospitals, who informed us that our previous care packages have been greatly appreciated by all doctors and patients. Also, most of the basic PPE and other equipment are now available. However, residents and junior doctors miss the small caring touches, especially during festival times. Hence, we focused on spreading cheer and goodwill and ending this difficult year on a positive note.

In the month of December our main focus was on procurement and distribution of care packages to patients, doctors, nursing and labor staff in all the major public and private hospitals. We distributed more than 1000 bags. This activity was managed entirely through our own funds and we spent approximately Rs.1,10,000/-.

- Distribution of care packages to patients
 - o 250 packages were distributed to patients in select teaching hospitals
 - o These packages contained handmade cotton mask, jaggery, roasted chana, biscuits, and a letter from MOGS in Marathi encouraging patients to stay safe
- Distribution of 487 care packages to resident doctors and Lecturers
 - o We distributed care packages to residents and lecturers in all the major public and teaching hospitals - KEM, Sion, Nair, JJ, Cooper, Wadia, Bombay Hospital, Somaiya and DY Patil
 - o We also distributed to SMO and residents in peripheral hospitals - KB Bhabha Bandra, KB Bhabha Kurla, VN Desai Santacruz, KBDA Kandivali
 - o For the first time we included select private teaching hospitals also - LH Hiranandani, Lilavati, Bhatia and Saifee hospitals
 - o A colorful bag filled with handmade cotton mask, sweet and savory goodies (candy, marshmallows, chips, kurkure, etc), Xmas hat/ headband and a letter from MOGS
 - o Distribution of 208 surplus bags in select institutes to patients and nursing and labor staff serving in the Obgyn department at the discretion of the HOD/ senior faculty
- Distribution of token of appreciation to 80 senior faculty
 - o A small token of appreciation was given to Professors and Associate Professors/ Honorary Consultants - a colorful bag with Christmas plum cake, a handmade cotton mask, and a letter from MOGS
- Surplus bags were also given to our Office staff as well as FOGSI staff.
- We supported artisans by ordering cotton masks from Dastkari Haat in Delhi, which showcases the work of artisans from all over India.
